## FS 3610 Textiles Materials + Exploration

## Credits: 3

Students will be challenged to explore textiles and materials from a conceptual and creative entry point. This course will cover surface design, fabric manipulation and knit design and weaving in both traditional techniques as well as with digital imaging technology such as Photoshop and Illustrator. This course will also explore new materials. Students will learn about fibers, textures and fabric substrates appropriate for each process and develop creative and unique personal approaches to their design projects.
