IL 2575 Illustration I

In this foundational illustration course, students learn to apply their problem-solving skills to make narrative illustrations in various media, such as pen and ink and cut-paper. Students are challenged to develop finished illustrations through a process of ideation, the use of reference photos, and figure/ground relationships that direct the meaning of the work. This course emphasizes the importance of value structure to create effective design, mood, lighting, and storytelling. Upon successful completion, students will have knowledge of how professional quality illustrations are produced. Students will render their ideas as finished works of art.
