

IL 3850 Digital Illustration I

In this junior-level course, students will combine traditional skills, analog materials, and digital media to learn a variety of methods for creating their artwork digitally. This course also defines and develops the necessary methods for producing powerful single-image illustrations that can quickly create meaning for broad audiences. Upon successful completion of this course, students will have explored visual metaphor and applied digital tools to various conceptual projects.
