

PH 3550 - ADVANCED PORTRAITURE

Credits: 3

This course prepares students for critical processes in developing strong narratives and personal aesthetics in advanced portraiture. Through lectures, discussions, and assignments, students gain skills in composition, body language, posing, lighting, and the importance of reinforcing the narrative of the individual subjects. Upon the completion of this course, students will gain insight and skills in the creation of a portrait portfolio that is consistent with industry-based professional practices.
