FS 2150 - ACCESSORIES

Credits: 3

This sophomore-level course focuses on three distinct categories of fashion accessory: footwear, handbags, and headgear/millinery. Students will examine the design and technical aspects of creating fashion accessories for complementing apparel. Form and function will be researched and analyzed from a historical and contemporary design perspective.

Materials will be investigated for accessory fabrication and construction including leather, plastics, felts, and novelties. Upon successful completion of this course, students will have a broad understanding of the design knowledge and technical skills associated with fashion accessory development.
